



PATHFINDER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD REQUIREMENTS

Beads - One red bead is awarded each PATHFINDER and parent for attendance at a regularly scheduled meeting (two per month - one meeting in the home and one outdoor activity). At each sixth (6th) meeting a white bear claw is awarded in lieu of a bead. Children can also earn colored beads through our Character Development program. A clear bead should be given when a child demonstrates **Caring**, a blue bead for **Honesty**, a yellow bead for **Respect**, and a green bead for **Responsibility**.

The Bear Claw Award is what both parent and child will work on during their tenure as a Pathfinder. Both will earn the claws for their bear claw together. They can earn the following colored claws for doing the suggested tasks. Claws will be given to your Navigator and should be presented to the children by the Navigator at the Circle meetings.

GREEN TIPPED BEAR CLAW

Memorize " Friends Forever". Explain to the Circle your Adventure Guide name, what it means and why it was chosen.

YELLOW TIPPED BEAR CLAW

Little pathfinder will learn about what big Pathfinder does and describe to others in the circle.

RED TIPPED BEAR CLAW

Arrange a night out for mom/dad. Big Pathfinder and Little Pathfinder will plan, purchase, cook and serve dinner. Mom/Dad are not allowed in the kitchen. Big and Little Pathfinder will also do the clean-up. Mom/Dad will write a short review of the experience to the Legend Keeper.

BLUE TIPPED BEAR CLAW

Complete a one-mile walking hike with parent. This can be part of a circle outing.

WHITE TIPPED BEAR CLAW

Share a special book, song or game with the circle.
